Each level grants +1 Fishing Rod Proficiency, increases the minimum fish size (in/cm) and bobber bar height, and decreases the max amount of time before fish bite. You can buy both at Willy's Fishmonger, located on the beach docks, south of Pelican town. The store is closed on Saturdays unless it rains. the Fiberglass rod will only be available to purchase upon reaching Fishing Level 2 while the Rod of iridium requires at least level 6 fishing. How to bait On the computer, to place the bait, you must open your Inventory Screen. It does not work in the Google bar. Then you need to left or right click on the bait. Left click will select all your baits, right click will select only one. After that, all you have to do is right click on the fishing rod. On PS4, press X on the bait to select the entire stack or the square to pick up a single one, then press the square to attach the bait to the rod. On Xbox, press A on the bait to select the entire stack or X to pick up a single one, then X to attach it to the rod. On Nintendo Switch, press A on the bait to select the entire stack or Y to pick up a single one, then Y to attach it to the rod. Tackle can lose its power if being used for a prolonged period of time. A green bar will appear one the tackle icon showing how much you've used up. List of Fishing Tackle Picture Name Description Spinner The shape makes it spin around in the water. Slightly increases the bite-rate when fishing. Trap Bobber Causes fish to escape slower when you aren't reeling them in. Cork Bobber Slightly increases the size of your "fishing bar". Dressed Spinner The metal tab and colorful streamers create an enticing spectacle for fish. Increases the bite-rate when fishing. Treasure Hunter Fish don't escape while collecting treasures. Also slightly increases the chance to find treasures. Barbed Hook Makes your catch more secure, causing the "fishing bar" to cling to your catch. Works best on slow, weak fish. Lead Bobber Adds weight to your "fishing bar", preventing it from bouncing along the bottom. The pole technically has a slot for the bait, which is easy to miss. Using bait and tackle can be a bit confusing for players new to Stardew Valley's fishing system. Here's a quick summary of how it's done, and what they do for you when fishing. If you need help with how to fish, click here. Bait First know that the Bamboo fishing pole has no slots available for bait nor tackle. The better rods have these features. The ability to use bait comes with Level 2 Fishing, as it will make Will sell the Fiberglass fishing pole at his shop by the beach for 1,800G (you should receive a letter indicating he has it available). You can also buy bait cheap there, though level 2 fishing teaches you to craft your own. How to Use Fishing BaitTo use bait, highlight the bait in your inventory, then pick it up as though you're going to move it. Now go to the fishing pole and right-click. The bait will now be equipped to the pole. With an Xbox controller you select it with 'A' and equip it to the fishing pole with 'X'. You can remove the bait by right-clicking or pressing 'X' a second time. You can attach a whole stack of bait so you only need to do this every now and then. Having bait equipped to a fishing pole will increase the speed at which fish 'bite'. This means less time sitting around, and more time reeling in the fish. It greatly increases your profit per day from fishing. Whether you catch the fish or not, you'll use up one of your bait. Tackle How to Use TackleTackle (spinners, barbed hooks, and bobbers) is equipped the same way. Pick up the tackle in your inventory, go over the fishing rod then right click or press 'X' on the Xbox controller to attach it to the pole. Tackle is only available from Fishing level 6 onward and requires you to buy the Iridium Fishing Rod, which has slots for both bait and tackle. Tackle has the largest effect on your ability to catch rare fish. Unlike bait, which decreases in quantity with each use, tackle has durability. Different types of tackle do different things: Spinner (Fishing Level 6) - Increases the rate that fish will bite. Lead Bobber (Fishing Level 6) - Stops the bar bouncing when it hits the bottom of the frame during the fishing minigame. Not useful very often. Trap Bobber (Fishing Level 6) - Makes the fishing minigame bar drop slower, meaning you don't have to click as fast to keep it steady on one level. One of the best. Cork Bobber (Fishing Level 7) - Increases the size of the bar in the fishing minigame by a bit, varies depending on your fishing level. Others are better. Remember, more fishing levels increases the size of the bar as well! Treasure hunter (Fishing Level 7) - Increases the chance of treasure chests appearing by 1/3 (meaning 20% total chance). Great for finding artifacts. These are crafted for 2 gold bars or bought for 750G from Willy. Dressed Spinner (Fishing Level 8) - Further increases the rate fish will bite. Barbed Hook (Fishing Level 8) - Helps the bar stick to the fish during the fishing minigame, making it easier. Like Stardew Valley's regular bait item, different types of tackle can be bought from Willy's shop as you level up. Naturally, you unlock the ability to craft the majority of these on the same level they become available in the shop, though a few are shop-exclusive. In general it seems better to buy them than to craft them, especially in the case of items like Treasure Hunter tackle unless you're swimming in Gold bars. And just like the HM games, there's a lot to do in Stardew that doesn't involve farming. From mining ore and adventuring through caves to slaying baddies and romancing your fellow villagers, there's one thing in the Valley that you're sure to be doing a lot of: fishing. Whether it's to get that perfect gift for that special someone or a hearty adventurer's meal, you'll do your fair share of fishing as you play through the game. But fishing can be hard sometimes. It's not always easy to land a big catch. That's where bait comes in. Let's look at what bait is, how to use it, and which pieces of bait are the best for which scenarios. What is Bait and How Do You Use It?Bait is an item that helps you catch fish in Stardew Valley. It can be attached to a Fiberglass Rod, an Iridium Rod, or inserted into a Crab Pot. Attaching bait to any fishing rod will apply effects that can better help the player catch fish. And, it's simple to use!To attach the bait to your rod, go to the inventory menu. Left-click on the bait in to pick it up (if you get too many pieces of bait, you can right-click to put some of the bait back into your inventory). Next, you need to right-click on the rod. The bait will disappear from your view but don't worry, it's still connected to the rod. If you're playing Stardew Valley on console, here are the controller commands for choosing and using bait for fishing: Xbox Controller: Press A on the bait to select the whole stack (or X to pick up a single piece). Then press X to attach the bait to the rod. PS4 Controller: Press X on the bait to select the whole stack (or Square to pick up a single piece). Then press Square to attach the bait to the rod. Leave the inventory menu and begin fishing. You can only use one bait per casting. Once you've used up all of the selected bait, you'll get a pop-up message from the game. Or, if you finish fishing without depleting your bait, you'll be able to use it next time. If you want to separate your rod and bait, just click on the inventory menu again and right-click the rod (or press X on the controller). Then you're finished.Different Types of Bait Have Different Usesjust like in real life, not every fish in the sea is going to be hungry for the same type of bait. Different baits have different uses -- and even buff your fishing skills. And did you know? You can even find treasures while fishing! Name Description Bait This makes fish bite faster and lowers the chance of getting trash.Can be bought for 5 gold or crafted with (1) Bug Meat. Magnet increases treasure discovery chance by 100%. Can be bought for 1,000 gold or crafted with (1) Iron Bar. Wild Bait All fish are attracted to this bait. It is a special recipe you must learn from Linus and cannot be purchased. You can craft it with (10) Fiber, (5) Slime, and (5) Bug Meat. --See? Easy peasy!
