Read moreG/O Media can get a commissionGIMP (Win/OS X/Linux)The GNU image manipulation program, aka GIMP, is well known and well loved for more than a few reasons. It is incredibly powerful, packing like many features like Photoshop itself, the fact that it is cross platformer and supports Windows, OS X, and Linux machines with ease (and with parity feature on all devices.) and, of course, because it is completely free. It has a fully modular and customizable interface, so you can keep your tools more used in front and center. It also has image correction utility that make photo manipulation and easy retouching, of you who have appointed GIMP praised it to enter the low price of \$0, but many of you have also reported problems with its interface and usability. It is true, the interface certainly leaves more than some things to desire, and it can be difficult to get used to if you are more accustomed to otherediting tools.
